Dr Danny Dhanasekaran obtained his PhD in 1985 from the Indian Institute of Science, India in Biochemistry and carried out his post-doctoral training at the University of Wisconsin, Wisconsin, USA from 1985–88. Following additional training at the National Jewish Center for Immunology and Respiratory medicine at Denver, Colorado, he joined the Fels Institute for Cancer Research and Molecular Biology in 1992 as a faculty member, where he is currently an Associate Professor. Dr Dhanasekaran is a major contributor in the study of G protein-mediated signaling and has made key observations concerning the function of the $G\alpha12$ and $G\alpha13$ subunits. He has linked these proteins to Rho family of proteins and to the stress-activated protein kinase cascade, leading to activation of the Jun kinases.
