in elucidating the mechanism of action of tranquillizers. The title of professor of physical metallurgy has been conferred on Dr. R. E. Smallman, senior lecturer in the Department of Physical Metallurgy. Dr. Smallman graduated in the University of Birmingham and from 1953 until 1958 worked at the Atomic Energy Research Establishment at Harwell, on crystallographic aspects of the plastic deformation of metals. Since his return to Birmingham he has built up a research group which is making significant advances in the application of theories of plastic deformation to a wide range of technically important materials.
