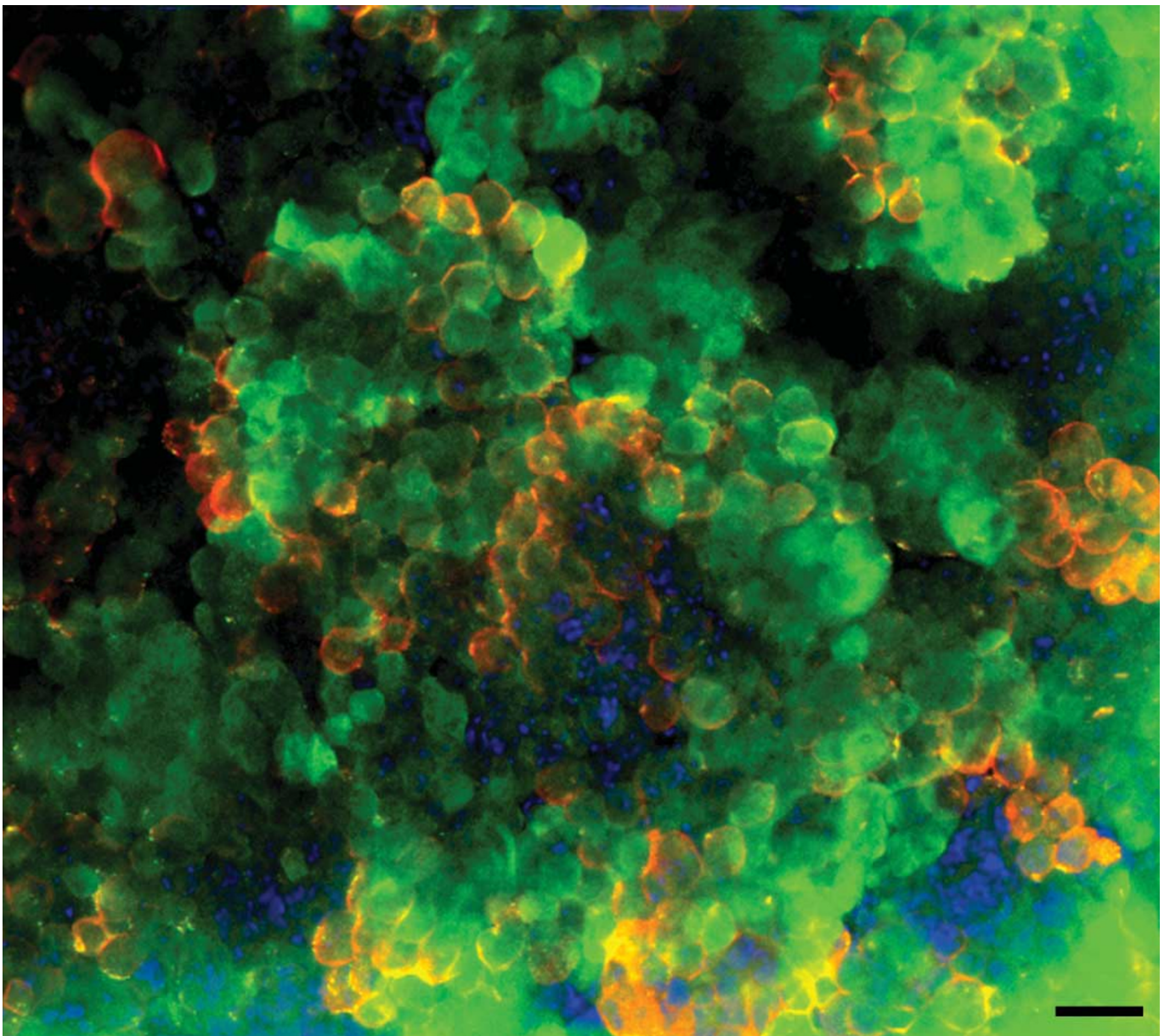


# CELL OF THE MONTH

It shows differentiating mouse embryonic stem (ES) cells.

Differentiating mouse ES cells were fixed and stained to highlight immature neurons (red), glial cells (green) and nuclei (blue). The image was obtained using a Zeiss Axioplan 2 microscope and SmartCapture 2 software. Bar, 30  $\mu$ m.
