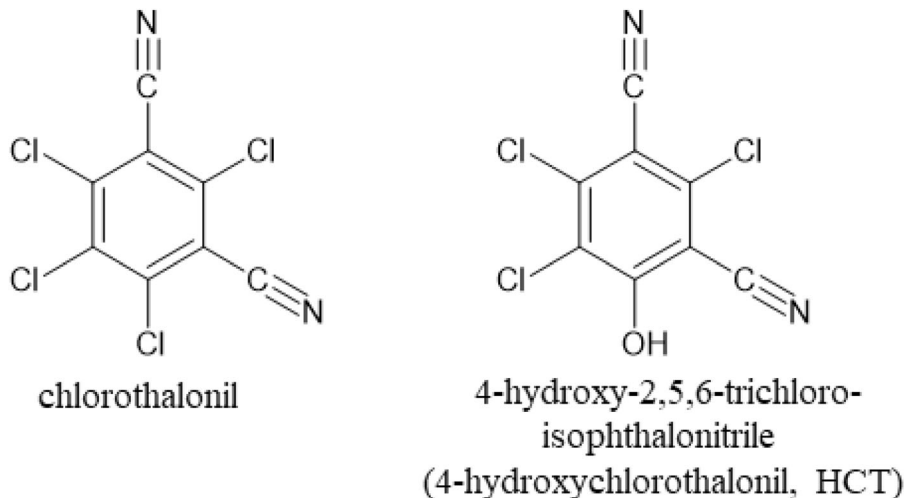



Fig. 1 Chemical structures of chlorothalonil and 4-hydroxychlorothalonil (HCT).

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

The corrected Fig. 1 is presented below:
